IDENTIFIER ET RÉAGIR

Step 2

OBSERVER ET ANALYSER

- Concentre-toi sur ce que tu vois et note des mots-clés pour décrire l'image.
 - Identifie sa structure en situant les différents éléments dans l'espace.
 - Explique ce que l'on peut apprendre des personnages en décrivant leurs gestes, leur attitude, leur regard, leur expression.
 - Observe les lignes et les couleurs qui composent le document et identifie les éléments de contraste et/ou de similitude qui s'en dégagent.
- *In the middle, the whole family is smiling. Contrary to the other members of the family who are all dressed in blue, Barack Obama's younger daughter Sasha is wearing a green dress. The use of the colour blue evokes/suggests strength and stability while the green may symbolise youth and hope.*
- *In the background, the circle-shaped seal makes me think of the halo that surrounds saints in religious portraits. It gives a religious connotation to the picture.*
- *In the bottom right-hand corner, the White House obviously stands for the American presidency. The fact that it appears inside the name "Obama" shows that the executive power is now vested in the new president.*

- Exprimer son ressenti : **What strikes me the most about this picture is (that)... • It arouses a feeling of joy ≠ sadness • empathy ≠ disgust • It makes me want to laugh ≠ cry, etc.**
- Parler de ses impressions : **The picture reminds me of... • We are under the impression that...**
- Commenter la prise de vue : **a close-up ≠ a wide-angle view • The subject is seen from above/below.**
- Décrire le regard : **stare at (fixer) • gaze at (contempler) • glance at (regarder furtivement) • glare at (lancer un regard furieux)**
- Mettre en relief : **The author wants to highlight/emphasise/ It draws the viewer's attention to/points out.**
- Évoquer l'atmosphère : **The author manages to convey/create a light-hearted ≠ oppressive • peaceful ≠ threatening • warm ≠ cold • idyllic ≠ nightmarish • pleasant ≠ desolate atmosphere**
- Le but recherché : **The author intends to show/demonstrate/prove/ denounce/suggest/encourage/motivate...**
